

Overview

This kit contains real fossils found in Santa Cruz County. They can be removed from the kit for observation and study, but please handle them with care, as they are real museum specimens. We have also provided supplemental information, materials, and activities to enhance student learning about local fossils.

Kit Activities & NGSS Standards

While the Fossil Kit activities can be adapted for many ages, they are specifically designed to meet the following NGSS Standards for grade 3.

NGSS Standards

3-LS4-1: Analyze and interpret data from fossils to provide evidence of the organisms and the environments in which they lived long ago

 LS4.A: Evidence of Common Ancestry and Diversity- Some kinds of plants and animals that once lived on Earth are no longer found anywhere. Fossils provide evidence about the types of organisms that lived long ago and also about the nature of their environments
